

## Regulations for Visitors to the Lahn-Dill-Kliniken

Updated: 03 June 2022

### Dear Patients and Visitors,

Patients in hospital can again be visited on a limited basis, but it is essential that visitors comply with hygiene regulations.

**Each patient can have one visitor per day.**

**A visit on the day of admission is also possible.**

### Please observe the following rules when visiting:

- The visitor must make an appointment **BEFORE each visit** using the **Contact Form** on our website, or via our Visitor-Hotline, which is staffed Monday to Friday, from 09:00 to 12:00
  - Visitors to Wetzlar and Braunfels, call: 06441 79 – 2079
  - Visitors to Dillenburg, call: 02771 396 – 4012
- **Visiting hours are daily from 14:00 to 18:00.** Last admittance is at 17:00. The maximum duration for a visit is **one hour**.
- The **visitor's name is recorded** and stored in the hospital information system.
- An identity check is carried out when registering as a visitor. Please provide valid photo identification (identity card, passport or driver license).
- The visitor must present a **certified negative test result** (Rapid Antigen test, max. 24 hours old; or PCR test, max. 48 hours old).
- Each registered visitor receives a **visitor badge** displaying the visitor's name, the date and time. This badge must be worn so as to be clearly visible.
- When at our hospital, **a visitor must go directly to the patient**. Visitors may not enter other areas of the hospital (cafeteria, smoking area, etc.). We urge visitors to follow staff instructions.
- Throughout the entire visit at our hospital, visitors **must wear a medical mask covering mouth and nose, or an FFP2 mask**. They must also adhere to hygiene measures as instructed by hospital staff. The **prescribed hygiene measures must be strictly adhered to** also on the ward and on the entire hospital premises. These include in particular:
  - Cough and sneeze etiquette. Use disposable tissues when coughing and sneezing, or alternatively, cough or sneeze into your elbow.
  - Thorough hand hygiene: Wash hands frequently and use hand sanitizer.
  - A **minimum distance of 1.5 meters** from the person being visited is to be maintained at all times.
  - If possible, only one visitor should be present per room.
  - Shaking hands, hugging, etc. must be avoided.
  - During the visit, the patient being visited is also required to wear a medical mask covering mouth and nose, or an FFP2 mask.
- The visitor must always **be symptom-free**.
- Visiting the **Intensive Care Unit** is possible as determined on an individual basis by the Senior Physician.
- It is **not possible to visit COVID wards** and **wards with suspected COVID cases**. Visitors to patients on these wards are referred to the „Kontaktbrücke“ („Contact Bridge“). Further information can be found on our website.
